## War and Peace in the Persian Gulf Region

### **Course Description and Objectives:**

This course will explore the complex dynamics of war and peace in the Persian Gulf region, focusing on the historical, political, economic, and strategic factors that have shaped conflict and cooperation among states in this critical area. Covering the period from the mid 20th century to the present, the course examines key events such as the Iran-Iraq War, the Gulf Wars, the U.S. military presence, regional rivalries (notably between Iran and Saudi Arabia), and the role of international actors and institutions.

The course will analyze the causes and preconditions of conflict and some efforts at conflict resolution in the Gulf region, examining what has generated the major interand intra-state conflicts in the region. Sources of conflict (nationalist, ideological, ethnic/sectarian, economic, territorial, geopolitical, and foreign manipulation and intervention) will be delineated and scrutinized. Our task will be to identify and explain the factors and actors that have made conflict and conflict resolution more (or less) likely. Both endogenous and exogenous factors will be evaluated and assessed. We will also delve into the likelihood for more inter-state conflict and external intervention in the region, concluding with an assessment of the impact of Israeli and American attempts at reigning in Iran's nuclear program.

Through interdisciplinary readings and case studies, participants will be introduced to the causes and consequences of militarization, energy geopolitics, sectarian tensions, and the rise of non-state actors. The course also investigates diplomatic efforts, peace building initiatives, and the prospects for long-term regional stability in a rapidly changing global context. By the end of the course, participants will gain a deeper understanding of the geopolitical importance of the Persian Gulf, the interconnected nature of regional conflicts, and the challenges and opportunities for sustainable peace.

#### **Learning Outcomes:**

By the end of the course, students will be able to:

- Analyze the historical and contemporary causes of conflict in the Persian Gulf region.
- Evaluate the roles of regional and international actors in both exacerbating and mitigating tensions.
- Understand the interconnection between energy geopolitics and security.
- Assess the prospects and challenges for sustainable peace in the region.
- Develop informed policy recommendations for regional stability and conflict resolution.
