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ANNUAL GROSS HOUSEHOLD INCOME – TYPES OF INCOME INCLUDED
 Includes before tax – earnings, unemployment compensation, workers' compensation, Social Security, Supplemental Security Income, public assistance, veterans' payments, survivor benefits, pension or retirement income, interest, dividends, rents, royalties, income from estates, trusts, educational assistance, alimony, child support, assistance from outside the household, and other miscellaneous sources.

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ANNUAL GROSS HOUSEHOLD INCOME CATEGORIES

1. Income thresholds are based on the U.S. Health & Human Services guidelines; these income thresholds are updated and published each year for the 48 contiguous states, Hawaii and Alaska.
2. To reflect the high cost of living in the San Francisco Bay Area the published 2015 low income thresholds for Alaska were chosen (also a high cost of living area) to establish the OLLI @Berkeley low income guidelines.
3. The Annual Gross Household Income levels in the table on Page 1 reflect 133% (Category 1) 145% (Category 2) and 185% (Category 3) of the 2015 published low income thresholds for Alaska

REVIEW & NOTIFICATION

- Scholarship applications are accepted up to 7 days prior to the start of each Term.
- Scholarship applications are reviewed once each week as they are received.
- The OLLI Business Manager may contact applicants for an interview to clarify financial information.
- After a decision regarding a scholarship application is made, the applicant will be notified.
- If granted a scholarship, the applicant will be informed that his/her OLLI Scholarship Membership has been established and the member may proceed to activate the membership. [See next section below]

MEMBERSHIP DUES AND COURSE FEES & LIMITS

- Following notification of an approved scholarship application, the recipient must pay the required Scholarship Membership dues of \$50 by check or credit card for the membership to be activated. (Membership dues cover 4 consecutive terms, which is 12 consecutive months)
- Once the Scholarship Membership dues are paid, the recipient may select courses, then register and pay the scholarship course fees related to his/her scholarship Category (1, 2 or 3) for OLLI courses (see below).
- Please review and follow the course type (A-D) limits per year as indicated in the table below.
